Folds of Honor is a 501(C)(3) nonprofit organization, rated a four-star charity by Charity Navigator and platinum on GuideStar, that provides educational scholarships to the spouses and children of military men and women who have fallen or are disabled as a result of active duty service in the United States armed forces. Our educational scholarships support private school tuition or tutoring for children in grades K – 12, as well as post-secondary tuition assistance for spouses and dependents.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DO I QUALIFY?

You must be the spouse or dependent child of a military service member who has fallen or is a disabled veteran with a combined service-connected rating through the VA. *Go to foldsofhonor.org/scholarships for specific age, marital status, and service member classification/ disability % requirements for each program*

HOW DO I APPLY?

Apply online by going to foldsofhonor.org/scholarships. Select the scholarship program that best fits your educational needs to find the application link.

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

The application link is only live during our annual window, which opens February 1st and closes on March 31st.
