Patrolman Chase Lee Maddox graduated from the Georgia Public Safety Training Center in 2013 and became the first officer hired by the Locust Grove Police Department directly from the academy. Prior to his law enforcement career, he proudly served at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, and continued his service in the Army Reserves for six years.

Known for his leadership and commitment to his community, Chase became a Field Training Officer and was deeply devoted to his wife, Alex, and their growing family.

On February 9, 2018, Officer Maddox was shot while assisting deputies during an attempted arrest. He passed away en route to the hospital at just 26 years old, four days before the birth of his youngest son.

In the wake of this loss, Alex became a Folds of Honor scholarship recipient, furthering her education while raising her two boys and honoring Chase's legacy.

Today, Alex serves as the Southern chapter president of Band of Blue, supporting families of fallen officers across the country. Guided by the values Chase lived by – service, strength, and family – she remains committed to building a future rooted in resilience and purpose.

Through the support of Folds of Honor, the Maddox family's story reflects how educational opportunity can help transform profound loss into lasting impact.
